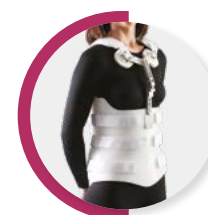

A professional and experienced model, Jacob has worked with many industry leaders such as global image agency, Getty Images, and featured in the Paralympics Advert in 2021.

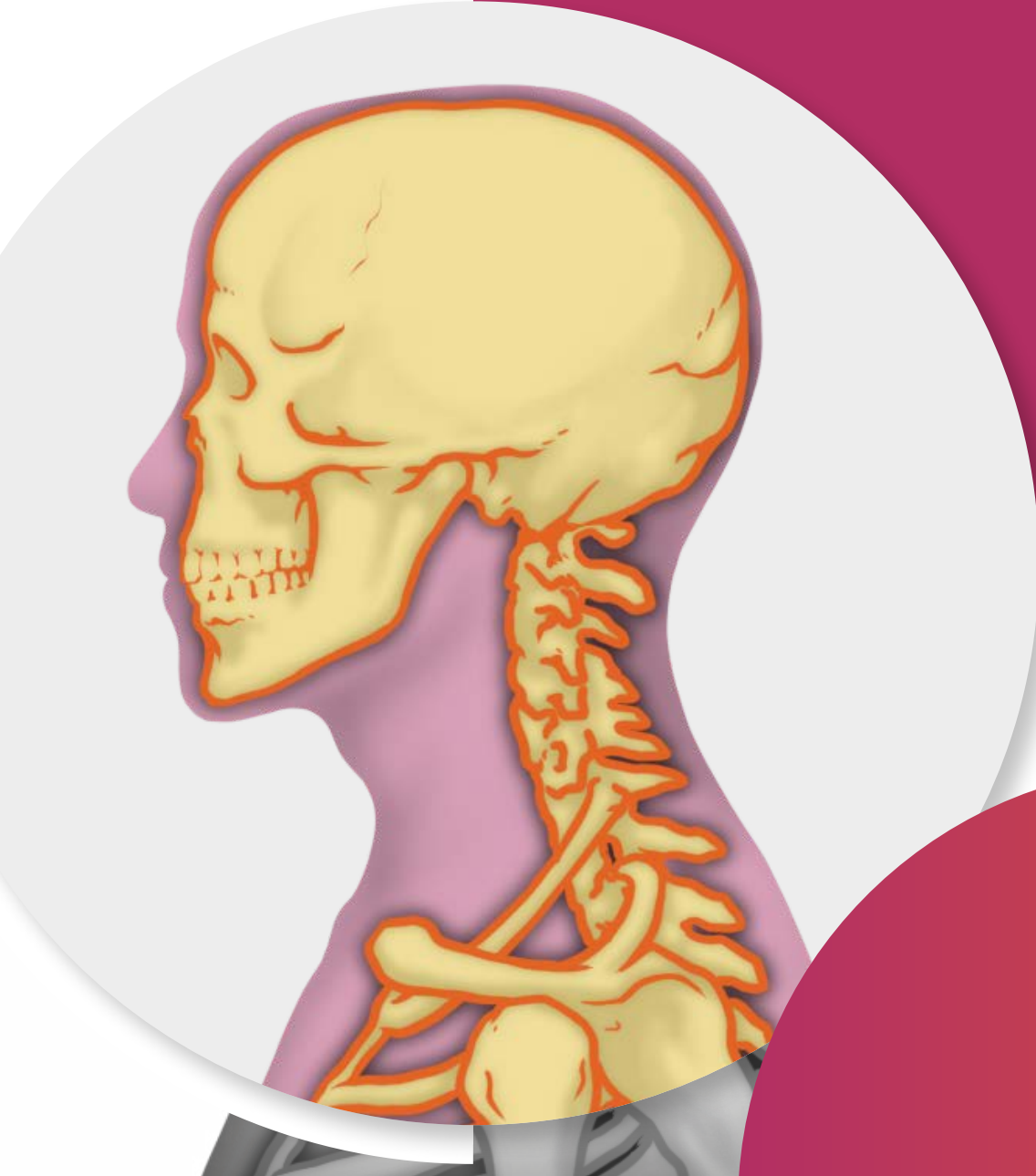

For adults and children with self-injurious behaviours and sensory disorders, orthotic helmets can provide life-changing treatment. At Steeper, one of our company's core values is Patient Focus and Michael embodies this value every day when he crafts top quality bespoke helmets for our patients.

Michael's skills and attention to detail have been instrumental in the development of new helmet designs that are more comfortable and effective for patients. For example, a patient with a sensory disorder who wore protective earmuffs came to our orthotic clinic needing an orthotic helmet. He could have crafted a helmet big enough to go over the patients' earmuffs, but if they were to be removed, the helmet wouldn't fit anymore. Michael knew there had to be a better way of giving the patient the noise reduction they required from the earmuffs, and the protection they needed from the helmet, so created the first-ever Steeper helmet with built-in earmuffs.

He's also pioneered helmets with tinted visors for patients who are intolerant to daylight.

He's worked with many clinicians over the years, and he says, *"My tip for Orthotists to get the best result first time would be to focus on the circumference and ear-to-ear measurements, if these are correct the fit will be too! However, if it's not suitable to measure your patient or if you can't, I'll happily work with you to get the best result."*

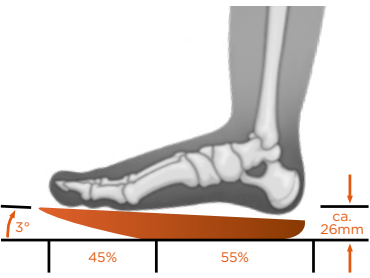

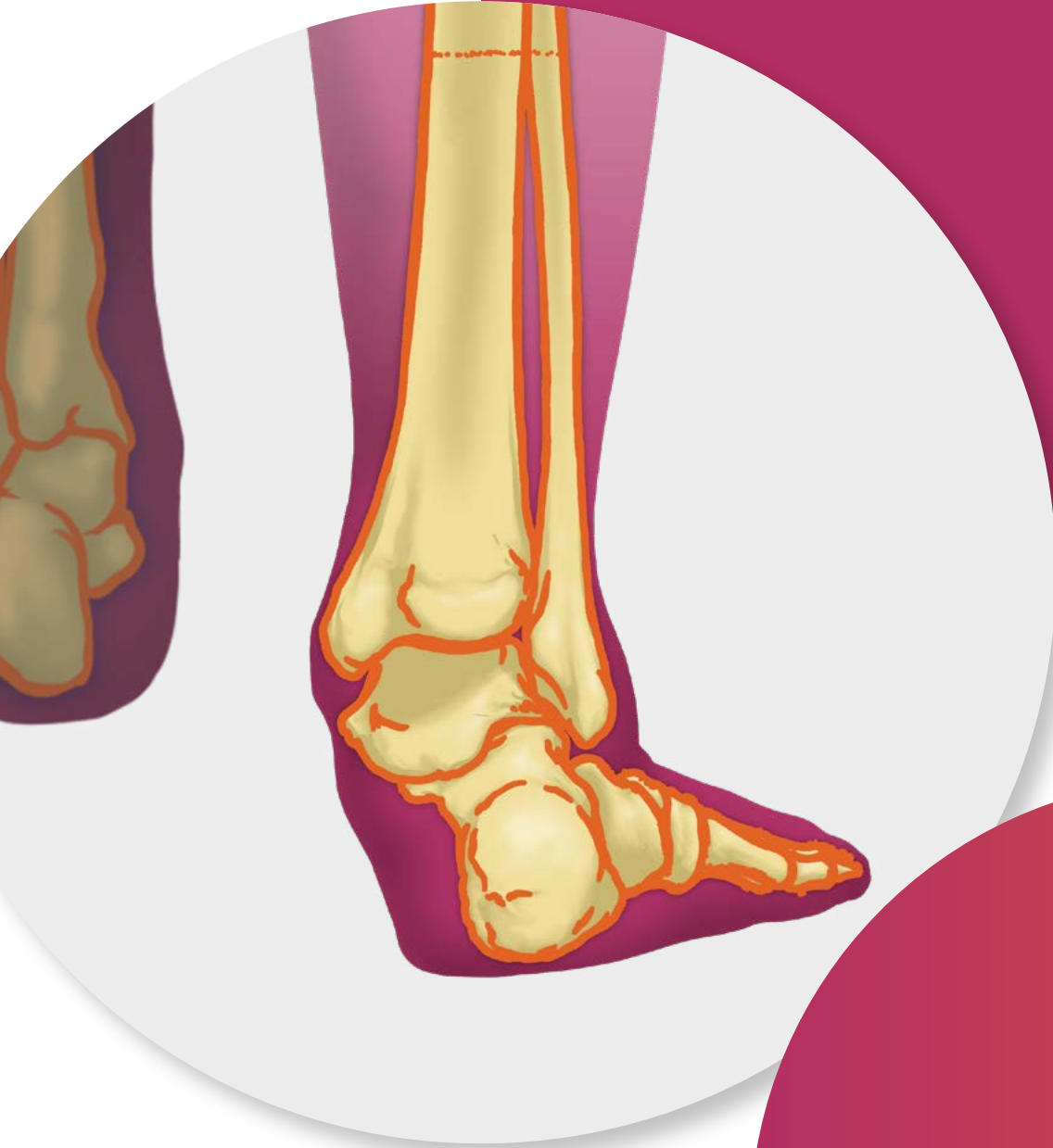

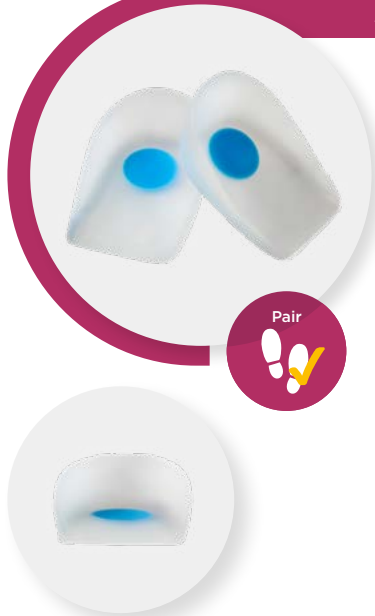
